**Motorcycle Safety:**

1. Wear helmet, jacket, pants and gloves
2. Have on boots or shoes that fully cover your feet
3. Maintain a safe distance between you and other riders
4. Stay in a staggered formation on the ride (all in one lane)
5. Respect all riders and drivers on the road



**Helmet Safety:**

Please note: Since the ride will cross both Missouri and Kansas state lines, all motorcycle laws must be observed by all participants. In particular, please be informed about helmet safety in each state.

Missouri: Driver and Passenger must wear a helmet.

Kansas: Anyone under the age of 18 must wear a helmet.
